



LOUISVILLE SAE MIDNIGHT MAYHEM

Baja SAE Teams,

You are invited to the 3rd Annual Midnight Mayhem hosted by the SAE chapter at the University of Louisville. The race will take place on the evening of Saturday, September 25th under the lights at Podium1 Motocross Track in Charlestown, Indiana (just 20 minutes north of UofL's campus). A single 4-hour endurance race under the lights will begin promptly at 8 p.m. with a moto-style land rush start. If your team is interested in some extensive driver training on an aggressive motocross track, come on out and watch an afternoon of the bikes tearing it up then prepare for some Midnight Mayhem! Podium1 has an excellent spectator grandstand. If you are a "local" school invite any and all interested, family and friends, they will have a good view of the race. All entries at a low price of \$10 per entry, SAE team member or spectator!!!!

Entrance fee is \$10 per team member at the gate, bring as many cars as you wish, so long as they comply to 2006 or newer rules. Registration is open until September 18, 2010. There will be a maximum number of 50 cars allowed to register, first come first serve.

Restrictions

- We will be doing a brief technical inspection
 - Vehicles must conform to 2006 or newer SAE rules and have the corresponding "Passed Tech" stickers on the car
 - Safety Gear, Brakes, Fasteners and Driver Egress
 - Clutch covers, Chain Guards, and the typical two functioning kill switches are required
- **ALL** SAE competition mandatory safety gear must be worn at all times while drivers are in the vehicles
- Governor settings must not exceed 4200 rpm and will be checked at the technical inspection
- Governor settings will be confirmed on the top five finishing cars at the completion of race. Penalty will be disqualification (i.e. no chance at any awards).

Please notify us as soon as possible if you wish to attend the 3rd Annual Louisville SAE Midnight Mayhem. Please inform us by filling out the Registration Form that was also posted on the Baja SAE forum. A brief listing of information needed is below:

1. Number of cars your team will be bringing
2. The car's identification number (if there are two cars with same numbers the second car to register will have a "x" placed behind the number, i.e. 10x)
3. An estimate of how many members/spectators will be attending from your school
4. Approximate dimensions of your truck & trailer so we can plan accordingly for parking

There are local hotels in the Southern Indiana and Louisville areas. Also camping is an option at the track at no cost if any teams are interested in saving money. Just let us know ahead of time, so we can have a general number of people staying at the track. Maps and other information will be posted soon.

The University of Louisville Baja SAE team looks forward to seeing your team at this Invitational event. We hope that all of you will enjoy it so we can continue to make this an annual event.
